The Bradford Reclamation District 2059 Board of Trustees voted to allow for landowner(s) on the Deed of Trust to have a ferry hanger(s).

The Ferry Hanger allows for FREE rides on and off the ferry.

Ferry Hangers are for the landowner(s) on the Deed of Trust ONLY

Example:

husband and Wife are both on the Deed of Trust - They may each have a Ferry Hanger

The Ferry Hanger is NOT transferable to family members or friends for use

The Ferry Hanger is NOT transferable to Contractors for use

Company Corporations are not allowed to provide members of their corporation a ferry hanger

Significant others of a landowner are not allowed to use the Ferry Hanger

Children, siblings nor any other family member may use the Ferry Hanger

When there was an initial vote to provide the landowner(s) with the Ferry Hanger(s), there was not an official set of rules drafted. Some property owners that owned more than one parcel, where provided with multiple Hangers. Every landowner that was on the district property tax list, was mailed a Hanger.

The Board of Trustees has made several motions over the years, since the original issuance of the Hanger(s)

There is ONLY one (1) Hanger allowed per property owner. Even if you own multiple properties.

One (1) Hanger will remain valid, and the others have been voided out

when a Hanger is lost, stolen or damaged, the original Hanger # is VOIDED and a NEW Hanger is issued

An updated list goes to the Delta Ferry Authority and the Ferry Captain.

If your Hanger is confiscated, it is NO longer valid due to the original amendments in the rules made by the Board of Trustees.

The Ferry Hanger has an assigned person to the number and the Ferry Captain is checking to ensure that they match.

Example:

APN # 000-00-000 - Property Owners Name - Ferry Hanger # 0000
