UPCOMING WINTER PREPARATIONS 2026 – 2027

Prepared People. Stronger Levees. A Safer Delta.

As the winter and rainy season approaches, Bradford Reclamation District No. 2059 will continue preparations to help protect Bradford Island, maintain the levee system, and ensure the District is prepared to respond to changing weather and water conditions.



LEVEE INSPECTIONS

- Increase inspections before and during significant storm events.
- Document erosion, seepage, boils, cracking, sloughing, animal burrows, settlement, and other areas of concern.



PUMP & DRAINAGE READINESS

- Inspect pumps, floats, oil levels, electrical components and discharge areas.
- Confirm all equipment is operational before major rainfall.



VEGETATION MAINTENANCE

- Continue appropriate vegetation management to maintain visibility and access for levee inspections.
- Follow applicable environmental requirements.



LEVEE REHABILITATION & REPAIRS

- Identify and prioritize areas requiring maintenance or rehabilitation.
- Coordinate necessary work with the District Engineer.



EMERGENCY MATERIALS & EQUIPMENT

- Verify availability of rock, sand, sandbags, plastic sheeting, fuel, pumps, tools, barricades, lighting and other emergency-response materials.



STORM & RIVER MONITORING

- Monitor weather forecasts, rainfall, river levels, tides and applicable flood advisories.
- Stay alert during significant weather events.



EMERGENCY ACCESS

- Keep levee roads and access points passable for District personnel, engineers, contractors and emergency responders.



COMMUNICATION & DOCUMENTATION

- Maintain current emergency contact information.
- Document inspections, conditions, maintenance activities, photographs and corrective actions.



COORDINATION

- The Levee Superintendent, District Engineer, District Manager, Board of Trustees, contractors and appropriate local/state agencies should coordinate when conditions require additional response.



LANDOWNER UPDATES

- Encourage landowners to regularly check the District website for storm-related information, ferry updates, meeting notices and other important District announcements.



Winter readiness is an ongoing responsibility.

Bradford Reclamation District No. 2059 remains committed to proactive inspection, maintenance, planning and communication to help protect Bradford Island and its levee system throughout the winter season.
